School Requests Gift for Capital Campaign

During the launch of a capital campaign for the school, Trevor expressed concern at the size of the campaign compared to the capacity of families. He convinced the school board to limit the campaign to \$20 million, and he agreed to commit 10 percent of funds with monitoring by Excellence in Giving.

When the campaign fell short, the school asked him for an additional \$2 million gift. In consultation with Excellence in Giving, Trevor agreed to provide the funds as a recoverable grant, interest free from his foundation.

While the Newmans could choose to forgive the grant, the recoverable structure also gave them the option to recycle the grant for future charitable purposes.

Excellence in Giving worked closely with the Newmans, their donor advised fund, and the school to structure the grant with appropriate terms.

Recoverable Funding Helped Everyone

The year the first payment was due, Excellence in Giving followed up with the headmaster of the school. Excellence in Giving knew that adhering to the original terms of the family’s gift would deepen their respect of the school’s leadership. So, Excellence in Giving encouraged the headmaster to make payments on time without requesting forgiveness of payments or an additional gift.
